

FLIGHT CREW GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Approved Minutes

October 21, 2010 Texas Cattle Co.

1. **The meeting was called to order** by Curt at 7:00 pm.
2. **Minutes** of the previous meeting were read and approved.
3. **Treasurer's Report: Wendy** – checking a/c bal is \$11,216.13. Bills should be given to Wendy for reimbursement if needed
4. **JetHawks Report:** There was no one at the meeting from the JetHawks so Curt gave a report. Curt said there are several players from the JetHawks playing in the Arizona Fall league. They are playing for the Peoria Javalinas. You can find them on-line to follow their progress.

The JetHawks won MiLB Give-Away of the Year with our Hanger Hero bobblehead but we did not win the overall.

The JetHawks will be affiliated with the Houston Astros for two (2) more years. The Dodgers are now at Rancho Cucamonga and the Angels are at Inland Empire. The Dodger organization is looking to possibly purchase the minor league team.

5. **JetHawks Field Announcer:** The new field announcer was not at the meeting.
6. **Old Business:**
 - a. **Shakey's Fund Raiser – Kathy:** We made approximately \$158 ± at the last Shakey's fundraiser. The previous fundraiser at the Souplantation netted about \$58 ±. Kathy reported that there will be no fundraising nights out during November, December and January. If you have any suggestions or ideas for fundraising please contact Kathy.
 - b. **Tree Lot Bake Sale – Barbara:** Our anticipated dates for the bake sale are December 10-12, 2011. Friday the 10th we will be there from 4:00 pm and Saturday the 11th and Sunday the 12th we will be there all day. Barbara will have a sign up sheet at the next meeting for volunteers to help at the tree lot. Also we will need baked goods. Christmas cookies and loaf bread, zucchini, banana, etc. sell well.
 - c. **Almonds – Barbara:** We netted approximately \$400 - \$500 ± from the sale of almonds. If you want any for Christmas gifts contact Barbara.
 - d. **Player Arrival Gift Card:** The Board voted to provide each JetHawk player with a \$20.00 Wal-Mart gift card at the beginning of the season only. We supply each apartment with the necessities, tissue, toilet paper, cleaning supplies, etc. but this would give them something toward groceries when they first arrive. Wal-Mart and Camille's have been very generous in their donations to the players and the booster club.
 - e. **Committee Realignment - Curt:** Committee chairmanships have been filled but volunteers are needed to help throughout the year.
 - f. **See's Candy – Curt for Arlene:** We still have some candy left. If you are interested, please contact Arlene. Next year we will be selling only the suckers.
 - g. **Membership – Darlene:** If you would like to renew you membership or join the Flight Crew now she would be happy to take your money tonight. She has the shirts, cards, and pins for those members who have already renewed and they can be picked up tonight. Anyone who renewed or joined tonight can see Darlene at the World Series party if they are going to be there or at the next meeting.

7. New Business:

a. 2011 Banquet – Dallas: Dallas Russell informed the membership that the Elks was using a different caterer for the coming year and their price was not acceptable to us. The new caterer, Taste Catering wanted \$31.82 per person for the buffet which would raise our tickets to \$40.00. Dallas mentioned that a couple of years ago, Elizabeth, Darlene's daughter, did some research on the Cascades but we were not able to go there at that time. Dallas approached the Cascades and we can get their Texas Barbeque including non alcoholic drinks. There would be an open, no host bar. We can still get in on Sunday to set up and they have a PA system and our video can be shown off the wall. The contract has been signed; banquet date is August 22, 2011. We would have to raise our ticket price to \$30.00, children \$15.00. A \$500.00 deposit was given to the restaurant to hold the date. Dallas has begun assembling his committee and will keep us informed of his progress. If you are interested in working on the committee, contact Dallas. We will need raffle prizes, auction items and players gifts. If anyone has any ideas for any of these items, please contact Dallas. We will not be able to bring in homemade cakes. We can purchase bakery cakes or other desserts to be served.
